IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to authorize the Commissioner of Agriculture to group the various Bureaus and lines of work in the Department of Agriculture into Divisions.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The commissioner of agriculture is hereby authorized to  
2 group the various bureaus and lines of work in the depart-  
3 ment of agriculture into divisions, to be known as divisions  
4 of animal industry, plant industry, markets, inspection and  
5 administration, appropriations made for the various bureaus  
6 and other lines of work in a division and any other funds  
7 available for the same purpose, shall be credited to that  
8 division. Hereafter, appropriations shall be made for each  
9 division, instead of separate appropriations for the several  
10 bureaus and lines of work.
