STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of Harry S. Coombs for preparing sketches and estimates and attendance before legislative hearings, making changes in said sketches and other expenses for the Board of Trustees for the Maine State School for Girls.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of four hundred and fifty-four dollars and sixty-three 3 cents (\$454.63) to be paid to Harry S. Coombs, architect, of 4 Lewiston, Maine, for labor, materials and time in preparing 5 sketches and estimates for central school building for the 6 board of trustees for Maine School for Girls, and attendance 7 upon legislative hearings at their request and changing said 8 sketches and estimates and other expenses accuring during 9 the years 1912, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 1917.
