STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to authorize the appointment of the Deering High School Commission in the City of Portland, Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The city council of the city of Portland is
2 hereby authorized to appoint a commission consisting of
3 three citizens of Portland, of whom the present mayor shall
4 be one, to whose supervision and execution shall be com-
5 mitted the designs, details, requirements and erection of
6 either a new high school building, in the Deering District,
7 so-called, or an addition to the present high school building,
8 as the city council shall direct. Each member of said com-
9 mission shall serve without pay, and the two members, other

10 than the mayor, shall be elected by the city council upon
11 nomination by the mayor or to serve until said new building,
12 or addition shall be completed; and any vacancies arising
13 from resignation or otherwise shall be filled in same manner.
14 Any succeeding mayor shall also be ex-officio a member of
15 said commission.

Sect. 2. Said commission may call and receive bids and
2 proposals for erecting said building, and in the name and on
3 behalf of the city execute such contracts therefor, as the city
4 council shall authorize, and shall see that the same are faith-
5 fully and promptly performed. Money appropriated by said
6 city council for erecting said building shall be paid out only
7 on the written approval of said commission, or a majority
8 thereof; and a report of its work and expenditure shall be
9 made at such times as the city council may require.
