IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Seventy-one of Chapter Fortyfive of the Revised Statutes, Relative to Use of Seines in Traps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section seventy-one of chapter forty-five of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end of said
3 section the following: 'and is also allowed to attach to said
4 weir or trap a net or seine, and a net or seine so attached
5 may be manipulated by the owner or person in charge in
6 such manner as to guide the fish up to and within said weir

7 or trap,' so that said section as amended shall read as 8 follows:

'Sect. 71. The owner or person in charge of any weir is 2 hereby permitted to use nets and seines in such weir, and 3 is also allowed to attach to said weir or trap a net or seine, 4 and a net or seine so attached may be manipulated by the 5 owner or person in charge in such manner as to guide the 6 fish up to and within said weir or trap.'
