STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-nine of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Duties of Superintendents of Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-nine of chapter sixteen of the revised statutes

- 2 is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and
- 3 substituting therefor the following:

'Sect. 49. The superintendent of schools in every town

- 2 shall return under oath to the school committee, in April
- 3 annually, a certified list of the names and ages of all persons
- 4 in the town from five to twenty-one years, corrected to the
- 5 first day of said month, leaving out of said enumeration all

6 persons coming from other places to attend any college or 7 academy, or to labor in any factory, or at any manufacturing 8 or other business.'
