## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Eight of the Revised Statutes Relative to the Office of Forest Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended 2 by adding after section seventy-one the following: 'For 3 such services the said deputy forest commissioner shall 4 receive annually the sum of seven hundred dollars, to be 5 paid from the funds provided under this act, in addition 6 to the salary now provided for the clerk to the land agent. 7 It is also hereby further provided that the forest commis-8 sioner shall receive from the funds provided under this 9 act, the sum of two thousand dollars per year in addition 10 to the salary as now provided by law.'
