STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Thirty-three of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes Relating to Vacancies in the Membership of Superintending School Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section thirty-three of chapter sixteen of the revised stat2 utes is amended by adding to said section the following,
3 words: 'In case any member of the superintending school
4 committee shall remove from the town or be absent for
5 more than ninety days a vacancy shall be declared to exist
6 and the remaining members shall within thirty days there7 after choose another member as hereinbefore provided.

8 Whenever the remaining members are unable to agree upon 9 a person to fill a vacancy the same may be filled by elec-10 tion at a town meeting called for the purpose,' so that said 11 section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 33. School committees first chosen shall designate 2 by lot a member or members to hold office for one, two 3 and three years respectively, in manner as follows: one 4 for one year, one for two years and one for three years; 5 and they shall certify such designation to the town clerk 6 to be by him recorded; and thereafterwards one member 7 shall be chosen by ballot at the annual meeting of the town, 8 to hold office for three years. Said committee may fill 9 vacancies occurring between annual meetings, and the term 10 of office of any member of the committee so chosen shall II expire at the next annual meeting. No member of the 12 superintending school committee of any town shall be em-13 ployed as a teacher in any public school in said town. In 14 case any member of the superintending school committee 15 shall remove from the town or be absent for more than 16 ninety days a vacancy shall be declared to exist and the 17 remaining members shall within thirty days thereafter 18 choose another member as hereinbefore provided. When-19 ever the remaining members fail to appoint a person to 20 fill a vacancy the same may be filled by election at a town 21 meeting called for the purpose.'
