STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Fixing of Salaries and Wages of Subordinates of the Several Departments of the State Government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The salaries or wages of all assistants, clerks

and other employees of the several departments of the state

government shall be fixed by the governor and council upon

the recommendation of the heads of the respective depart
ments.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are 2 hereby repealed
