RESOLVE, to Appropriate Money for the Purchase of History of York.

Resolved: That one hundred and twenty-five copies of 2 the History of York, the first English city on this Continent, 3 by Edward C. Moody, be purchased by the state at a cost of 4 \$2.00 per copy, the same to be distributed in high schools or 5 elsewhere at the discretion of the state librarian, or library
