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AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Fifteen of Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen to Provide for Payment of a Bounty on Bears Killed in the State.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter two hundred fifteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen is hereby amended by adding to said section the following words: 'and so much of the fees received for dog licenses as may be necessary to pay said bounties, is hereby appropriated to pay the

6 same'; so that as amended said section shall read as fol-  
7 lows:

'Sect. 5. Bounties to be paid from dog licenses. The boun-  
2 ty so paid by the state treasurer shall be taken from the  
3 fees received from the licenses of dogs, in the State of  
4 Maine, and so much of the fees received for dog licenses as  
5 may be necessary to pay said bounties, is hereby appro-  
6 priated to pay the same.'
