STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine State Prison for Maintenance and Current Expenses.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated for
2 the Maine State Prison, for the year nineteen hundred and
3 nineteen, the sum of eighty-three thousand five hundred
4 dollars, for the purposes hereinafter specified, namely:

Services of officers and employees, forty-five thou-

sand three hundred dollars	\$45,300 00
Food supplies, sixteen thousand dollars :.....	16,000 00
Clothing, three thousand dollars	3,000 00
Repairs on buildings, four thousand dollars	4,000 00

General expenses, eleven thousand four hundred dollars	11,400 00
Retiring and pensioning prison officials, three thousand eight hundred dollars	3,800 00

Provided, that any balances of the foregoing appropriations which remain unexpended at the end of the year nineteen hundred nineteen shall be available for expenditure during the year nineteen hundred twenty.

And be it further resolved, that there be, and hereby is, appropriated for said Maine state prison for the year nineteen hundred twenty, the further sum of eighty-three thousand five hundred dollars for the same purposes as hereinbefore specified for the year nineteen hundred nineteen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The foregoing resolve specifically states the purposes for which it is asked and required for the maintenance of this state institution.
