STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE for the Improvement of the State Prison at
Thomaston.

Resolved: That the sum of sixty-five thousand dollars
2 be, and the same is hereby appropriated to provide for the
3 following improvements and additions to the state prison at
4 Thomaston, the same to be expended by the Board of
5 Prison Commissioners subject to the approval of the Gov-
6 ernor and Council:

7 Purchase of two farms	\$15,000
8 General construction and improvement of said	
9 prison	\$50,000

10 Said last named sum to be available in the year nineteen
11 hundred twenty.
