AN ACT to Amend Section Seventy-one of Chapter Forty-
five of the Revised Statutes, Relative to Use of Seines in
Traps.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventy-one of chapter forty-five of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end of said
3 section the following: 'and is also allowed to attach to
4 said weir or trap a net or seine not over six hundred feet
5 in length, providing that no part of the net or seine is less
6 than one thousand feet from any other weir or trap; and
7 a net or seine so attached may be manipulated by the owner

8 or person in charge in such manner as to guide the fish up
9 to and within said weir or trap,' so that said section as
10 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 71. The owner or person in charge of any weir is
2 hereby permitted to use nets and seines in such weir, and
3 is also allowed to attach to said weir or trap a net or seine
4 not over six hundred feet in length, providing that no part
5 of the net or seine is less than one thousand feet from any
6 other weir or trap; and a net or seine so attached may be
7 manipulated by the owner or person in charge in such
8 manner as to guide the fish up to and within said weir or
9 trap.'
