AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Passadumkeag Boom  
Company.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In addition to the rights and privileges contained in chapter three hundred and twenty-six of the private acts of eighteen hundred sixty-four, as amended by chapter three hundred and seventy-two of said acts, and as further amended by the private acts of eighteen hundred sixty-six, chapter fourteen, the Passadumkeag Boom Company is hereby given further rights and privileges as follows:

Sect. 2. The Passadumkeag Boom Company is hereby

2 empowered to erect a dam across Passadumkeag Stream,  
3 just above Hathaway Bridge, so-called, for the purpose of  
4 ponding water sufficient to enable it to perform its present  
5 obligations under its charter and also in order that it may  
6 hold logs and lumber above said dam in order that they  
7 may be there stopped and sorted and held, or rafted or  
8 turned by, as the owners may, in writing, direct.

Sect. 3. Owners of logs and lumber, destined for the  
2 Penobscot river but stopped for the purpose of sorting  
3 and being turned by, shall be at no expense by reason  
4 hereof.

Sect. 4. The company may take enough real estate for  
2 the erection of said dam and a reasonable right of way  
3 thereto from the highway, and shall have the right to flow,  
4 so far as the same may be necessary, by reason of the erec-  
5 tion of said dam, all upon payment of reasonable compensa-  
6 tion therefor.
