AN ACT Amending Section One Hundred Seventy-two of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Teachers' Pensions and Giving Full Pension to Teachers Retiring Prior to September Thirty, Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred seventy-two of chapter sixteen of  
2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 following words at the end of said section one hundred  
4 seventy-two, viz: "except that the amount of the pension  
5 allowed to such person shall be one-half of any amount  
6 designated under the foregoing sections," and inserting in  
7 place thereof the following words, viz: "and the amount of

8 said pension shall be determined by the length of service  
9 as provided in the three preceding sections,' so that said  
10 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 172. Any person who otherwise meets the require-  
2 ments of the three preceding sections, but shall have retired  
3 or shall have been retired prior to the school year next pre-  
4 ceding the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred  
5 thirteen, shall be entitled to receive a pension under the pro-  
6 visions of this section and the three preceding sections, and  
7 the amount of said pension shall be determined by the  
8 length of service as provided in the three preceding sec-  
9 tions.'
