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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE**

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AN ACT to Authorize the City of Lewiston to Issue Its Bonds to the Amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars to Pay Its Bonds Now Outstanding and Maturing in the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-three.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

To meet its bonds now outstanding and maturing in the  
2 year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three the city  
3 of Lewiston is authorized to issue bonds to an amount not  
4 exceeding one hundred thousand dollars payable at a period  
5 or periods not exceeding twenty years after the date thereof  
6 and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding five per cent  
7 per annum, payable semi-annually; said bonds shall be issued

8 in serial form and shall mature in the following manner,  
9 to wit: Five thousand dollars in one year after the date of  
10 issuance and five thousand dollars on each and every year  
11 succeeding until the whole issue is fully paid. Said bonds  
12 shall be issued under the seal of the city and shall be signed  
13 by the mayor and treasurer of the city, and the coupons  
14 attached to said bonds shall have the printed or lithographed  
15 signature of the treasurer.
