STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for General Forestry
Purposes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the
2 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars; five thousand dollars
3 for the six months ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred
4 and twenty-one, ten thousand dollars for the year ending
5 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, and ten
6 thousand dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, nine-
7 teen hundred and twenty-three, for general forestry pur-
8 poses, including the reforestation of waste land acquired
9 by the state by purchase or otherwise, the encouragement
10 of reforestation by private owners, the enforcement of all

11 existing and future legislation relating to forestry and the
12 general improvement of forest growth both within and with-
13 out the Maine Forestry District. Said fund shall be ex-
14 pended under the direction of the forest commissioner and
15 any balance unused at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse
16 but be carried over into the permanent fund provided by
17 chapter forty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred
18 and nineteen and used in accordance with the terms of that
19 act.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The money hereby sought to be appropriated is to be used for the purposes outlined in chapter forty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen.
