## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for General Forestry Purposes.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of twenty-five thousand dollars; five thousand dollars 3 for the six months ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred 4 and twenty-one, ten thousand dollars for the year ending 5 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-two, and ten 6 thousand dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, nine-7 teen hundred and twenty-three, for general forestry pur-8 poses, including the reforestation of waste land acquired 9 by the state by purchase or otherwise, the encouragement 10 of reforestation by private owners, the enforcement of all

existing and future legislation relating to forestry and the general improvement of forest growth both within and without the Maine Forestry District. Said fund shall be expended under the direction of the forest commissioner and any balance unused at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse but be carried over into the permanent fund provided by chapter forty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen and used in accordance with the terms of that act.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The money hereby sought to be appropriated is to be used for the purposes outlined in chapter forty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nineteen.
