## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Regulate the Laws of Fishing in the Waters

Around Monhegan Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter sixty-one, section one of the private and special

- 2 laws of nineteen hundred and seven, as amended by chapter
- 3 two hundred and ten, section one of the private and special
- 4 laws of nineteen hundred and nine, is hereby amended by
- 5 striking out all of said section and inserting in place there-
- 6 of the following: 'It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill,
- 7 destroy or set any lobster trap or other device for the pur-
- 8 pose of taking, catching, killing or destroying any lobster,

9 or lobsters, within two miles of the shore of Monhegan 10 Island between the twenty-fifth day of June of each year 11 and the first day of November following,' so that said sec12 tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Section I. It shall be unlawful to take, catch, kill, de-2 stroy or set any lobster trap or other device for the purpose 3 of taking, catching, killing or destroying any lobster, or 4 lobsters, within two miles of the shore of Monhegan Island 5 between the twenty-fifth day of June of each year and the 6 first day of November following.'
