STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Make Legal and Valid the Annual Town Meeting of the Town of Crawford, in the County of Washington, Held March Twenty-ninth, Nineteen Hundred Twenty.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas it is necessary to enforce the collection of taxes assessed in the town of Crawford, in the county of Washington, for the municipal year of 1920-1921 in order to provide funds to carry on the business affairs of the town, and whereas these facts render the passage of this act immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace and safety, and constitute an emergency within the meaning of the constitution, now therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

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Section 1. Acts of annual town meeting of March twenty-2 ninth, nineteen hundred and twenty, validated. All the pro-3 ceedings, acts and doings of the inhabitants of the town of 4 Crawford, in the county of Washington, at the annual town 5 meeting held in said town on Monday, March twenty-nine, 6 nineteen hundred and twenty, are hereby confirmed, legal-7 ized and made valid.

Sect. 2. Emergency clause. In view of the emergency 2 cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when ap-3 proved.

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
