STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Sixteen of the Private and Special
Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Eleven, Relating to the Issue
of Stock and Bonds by the Lewiston Gas Light Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter sixteen of the private and special laws of nineteen
2 hundred and eleven is hereby amended so that it shall read
3 as follows:

“The Lewiston Gas Light Company, a corporation created
2 by special act of the legislature and charged with the per-
3 formance of a public duty, is hereby authorized to increase
4 its capital stock to not exceeding one million dollars, and
5 to issue bonds secured by mortgage upon its property and

6 franchise in a sum not exceeding one million dollars at any
7 one time outstanding.

The stock authorized by this act may be issued either as
2 common or preferred, from time to time and upon such
3 terms and conditions as the corporation may determine, and
4 the bonds may be issued from time to time under one or
5 successive mortgages or in separate series under the same
6 mortgage, in such amount or amounts and on such terms
7 and conditions as the corporation may determine; provided,
8 however, that the issue of such capital stock and bonds shall
9 be subject to the provisions of section thirty-seven, chapter
10 fifty-five of the revised statutes and acts amendatory thereof.
