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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-ONE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Seventy-eight of Chapter Eleven of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Sale of Real Estate for Taxes in Incorporated Places.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventy-eight of chapter eleven of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of the last four lines of said section which includes the sentence beginning with the word "after", so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 78. The person interested in the estate, by purchase at the sale, may pay any tax assessed thereon, before or

3 after that so advertised, and for which the estate remains  
4 liable, and on filing with the treasurer the receipt of the  
5 officer to whom it was paid, the amount so paid shall be  
6 added to that for which the estate was liable, and shall be  
7 paid by the owner redeeming the estate, with interest at the  
8 same rate as on the other sums.'
