# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Mary C. Kimball, of Carmel.

Resolved: That a pension of ten dollars per month be, 2 and hereby is, granted to Mary C. Kimball, of Carmel, to 3 be paid quarterly from the fund appropriated for soldiers' 4 pensions. Said pension shall begin July first, nineteen hun-5 dred and twenty-five, and continue until otherwise provided 6 by the Legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Marq C. Kimball is the daughter of Charles F. Kimball, a Civil War Veteran, now deceased. She was dependent upon her father until his death. She is now seventy years of age, and has no income except what she can earn by taking in washings.
