STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Increase the State Pension of Maria N. Varrell of York.

Resolved: That the pension of six dollars per month 2 granted to Maria N. Varrell of York, under the provisions 3 of chapter eighteen of the resolves of nineteen hundred 4 twenty-three, be increased to eight dollars per month, beginning January one, nineteen hundred twenty-five. Which 6 payment shall be in lieu of any other state pension now provided by law.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Varrell is the widow of the late Harmon Varrell, who received a state pension of eight dollars per month. Mr. Varrell died without leaving estate of value. Since his death she has been paid six dollars per month. She recently underwent operation and treatment at the York Hospital. She is seventy years of age, and her general health is poor.
