STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Towns Uniting for the Purpose of
Breaking Snow.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Towns which are traversed by the same state
2 highway, may, by an appropriate article in the warrant call-
3 ing the annual town meeting, or in the warrant calling a
4 special town meeting, unite for the purpose of breaking
5 and removing the snow from such highways.

Sect. 2. The selectmen of the towns which vote to form
2 such union, shall be a joint committee and shall determine
3 the relative amount of expenditures incurred in the break-
4 ing and removal of snow upon and from said highway,
5 which shall be a town charge. They shall apportion the

6 amounts to be paid by the several towns in such union,
7 which shall be determined by dividing the entire amount of
8 expenses paid by the several towns comprising unions in
9 the proportion of each town's valuation made by the state
10 assessors in the next prior year.

Sect. 3. The selectmen of the several towns comprising
2 such union are hereby authorized to purchase, lease, hire
3 or otherwise provide the proper instrumentalities for such
4 breaking and removal of snow, and the apportionment there-
5 for shall be as provided in section two.
