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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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RESOLVE, Authorizing the Purchase by the State of Maine of that Portion of the Interstate Toll Bridge, between South Berwick in the County of York and Dover, New Hampshire, which is within limits of the State of Maine.

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*Resolved:* That the governor, with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire by purchase, at a price not to exceed thirty-five hundred dollars, that portion of the Interstate toll bridge, between the town of South Berwick in the County of York and the City of Dover, New Hampshire, which lies within the limits of the State of Maine, and open same for free travel.

This resolve is not to take effect or become operative unless  
2 the State of New Hampshire shall by appropriate legisla-  
3 tion, authorize the purchase and opening for free travel of  
4 that portion of said bridge which lies within the limits of  
5 said State of New Hampshire.
