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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT to Authorize the State Auditor to Carry Forward to the Succeeding Year Construction Accounts and to Constitute Them Continuous Carrying Accounts for the Purposes Designated by the Legislature.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All appropriations by the legislature for the construction  
2 of buildings, highways and bridges shall constitute con-  
3 tinuous carrying accounts for the purposes designated by  
4 the legislature in such appropriations and the state auditor  
5 is hereby authorized to carry forward all such appropria-  
6 tions to the succeeding fiscal year; provided, however, that

7 any balance remaining after the completion of the object of  
8 the appropriation shall revert to general income in the state  
9 treasury or to the fund from which it was apportioned under  
10 existing provisions of law.
