RESOLVE, in Favor of Emily F. Grotton of Washington, for
State Pension.

Resolved: That there be paid to Emily F. Grotton of
2 Washington, the sum of fifteen dollars per month, payable
3 quarterly from the fund appropriated for soldiers' pensions,
4 beginning on January one, nineteen hundred and twenty-
5 five and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This widow is unable to receive a United States pension as her husband was not sufficiently long in the service. She is practically destitute and if aid is not given to her, it is feared that she will become a town charge.
