STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Taking of Fish from Birch Harbor
Pond, in Winter Harbor, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in Birch
3 Harbor Pond, in the town of Winter Harbor, in the county
4 of Hancock, except it shall be lawful to fish through the ice
5 in said pond during the months of February, March and
6 April of each year in accordance with the general ice fishing
7 laws of the state.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-

2 sion at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any
3 provision of this section.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall
2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more than
3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and an additional
4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or
5 had in possession, in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 3. Trial Justices, Police and Municipal Courts with-
2 in their respective counties, shall have, upon complaint,
3 original and concurrent jurisdiction with the Supreme Judi-
4 cial Court and Superior Courts in all prosecutions arising
5 under this act.
