STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

**AN ACT to Repeal Acts Incorporating Pittsfield Village
Corporation.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All acts heretofore enacted for the incorpo-
2 ration of the Pittsfield Village Corporation within the pres-
3 ent town of Pittsfield in the county of Somerset are hereby
4 repealed; provided, that the corporate existence, powers,
5 duties and liabilities of said Pittsfield Village Corporation
6 shall survive for the purpose of prosecuting and defending
7 all actions and causes of action to which said Pittsfield Vil-
8 lage Corporation is a party, and collecting payment of all
9 claims and demands now existing in favor of or against

10 said Pittsfield Village Corporation and all needful processes
11 growing out of the same.

Sect. 2. The town of Pittsfield may, at a meeting legally
2 called by a warrant and containing an article for that pur-
3 pose, by vote, assume all the outstanding liabilities of said
4 Pittsfield Village Corporation on the day when this act takes
5 effect, and in case said town so votes, they shall have au-
6 thority to raise money by loan upon town orders, notes or
7 bonds which shall be valid claims upon said town, with
8 which to discharge such liabilities, and thereupon all the
9 property and assets of said Pittsfield Village Corporation
10 shall become the property of and vested in said town.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when accepted by a
2 majority of the legal voters of Pittsfield present and voting
3 at any annual meeting of said town, the warrant containing
4 an article for that purpose.
