STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Howard Pond, in Hanover, in
the County of Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish in Howard pond, in Han-
3 over, in the county of Oxford, from July first of each year
4 to September thirtieth following, both days inclusive, by
5 means of plug fishing, so-called.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-
2 sion at any time any kind of fish taken in said pond in
3 violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provisions of this act shall

2 be subject to a penalty of not less than ten nor more than
3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and an additional
4 penalty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or
5 had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 3. Trial justices, police and municipal courts, within
2 their respective counties, shall have, upon complaint, orig-
3 inal and concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial
4 court and superior courts in all prosecutions arising under
5 this act.
