STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, for State Pension in Favor of Rena Cooley.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the 2 sum of three hundred dollars for the year ending June 3 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-six and the sum of 4 three hundred dollars for the year ending June thirtieth, 5 nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to be paid in quarterly 6 payments of seventy-five dollars each to Rena Cooley of 7 Augusta, for and in behalf of herself and her minor children, 8 Violet and Evely, under the supervision of the governor 9 and council.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The husband of Rena Cooley, father of these minors, for a number of years was employed at the Maine State Hospital for the Insane, at Augusta. In the course of his employment he was assaulted and killed by an inmate. The mother and children are left destitute and without remedy at law.
