RESOLVE, in Favor of Central Maine Sanatorium.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is appropriated for
2 the Central Maine Sanatorium, for the period from July
3 first nineteen hundred twenty-five to June thirtieth nineteen
4 hundred twenty-six, for the erection and equipment of a
5 home for nurses connected therewith, thirty-five thousand
6 dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the present time the nurses are housed in a building over the kitchen in poorly lighted, ventilated and heated rooms. In order to keep a suitable class of nurses in the employ of this institution, it is absolutely necessary to furnish them proper housing facilities.
