RESOLVE, Making Available Funds for the State's Share of Reconstruction Under the Bridge Act of the Substructure of the Gardiner and Randolph Bridge.

EMERGENCY PREAMBLE. Whereas, the bridge between the city of Gardiner and the town of Randolph in this state is out of repair and its condition such as to constitute a menace to the safety of travelers thereon, and extensive repair thereof is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and

Whereas, the foregoing facts constitute an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of this state; now therefore,

Resolved: That the sum of thirty-two thousand five hun-

2 dred (\$32,500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be nec-
3 essary, be and hereby is appropriated as the share of the
4 state under the provisions of the bridge act, so-called, for
5 rebuilding the substructure of the bridge between the city
6 of Gardiner and the town of Randolph in the county of
7 Kennebec, the same to be expended under direction of the
8 state highway commission under the provisions of the said
9 bridge act. Said sum shall be available for expenditure
10 until June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven.
11 The equivalent of any sum expended by the state under the
12 provisions of this resolve shall be transferred to the general
13 fund in the treasury from any funds becoming available for
14 the administration of the bridge act prior to June thirtieth,
15 nineteen hundred and twenty-six.

In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this re-
2 solve shall take effect when approved.
