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**STATE OF MAINE**

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT to Authorize the Construction and Maintenance of  
a Bridge Across Beach Creek in Bristol.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The inhabitants of the town of Bristol are hereby authorized and empowered to build and maintain a bridge suitable for public travel by foot, teams and motor vehicles, across so-called Beach creek, a tide-water shallow channel in the southern part of the village of Pemaquid Beach and lying between said village and so-called Fish point on the west, the location to be the same as that of the present wooden bridge over said creek. Said bridge shall be constructed and maintained in accordance with the acts of con-

10 gress pertaining to bridges and wharves over and across  
11 tide-waters and shall be maintained by the said town of  
12 Bristol. Said town is also authorized to lay out, build and  
13 maintain a public highway over and across such bridge.
