STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

AN ACT Relating to Fishing in Certain Waters in Franklin and Oxford Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to fish for, take, catch or kill any fish at any time in Upper and Lower Richardson lakes, and all their tributaries, or in Rapid river between Lower Richardson and Umbagog lakes, or in Pond-in-the-River, so-called, in said Rapid river, all of which waters are in the county of Oxford, except between sunrise and one half hour after sunset of each day.

Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to a penalty of not less than ten dollars nor more than

3 thirty dollars and costs for each offense, and a further pen-
4 alty of one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had
5 in possession in violation of this act.
