STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Section 11 of Chapter 260 of the Public Laws of 1917, as Amended by Chapter 160 of the Public Laws of 1921, Increasing the Salary of the Stenographer of the Androscoggin Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section eleven of chapter two hundred and sixty of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen as amended
3 by chapter one hundred and sixty of the public laws of
4 nineteen hundred and twenty-one is hereby amended by
5 striking out in the seventh and eighth lines the words "eight-
6 een hundred dollars annually" and inserting in place thereof
7 the words 'twenty-one hundred dollars annually,' so that
8 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 11. The justice of said court may appoint a sten-
2 ographer to report the proceedings thereof, who shall be an
3 officer of the court and be sworn to a faithful discharge of
4 his duty, and who shall perform the duties prescribed and
5 be subject to the provisions of the revised statutes, chapter
6 eighty-seven, sections one hundred and sixty-seven to one
7 hundred and seventy-two inclusive, so far as the same may
8 be applicable. The salary of said stenographer shall be
9 twenty-one hundred dollars annually, to be paid quarterly
10 from the treasury of the county.'
