STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT to Amend Paragraph XVII of Section Six of Chapter One of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Rules of Construction; Corporate Seals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Paragraph XVII of section six of chapter one of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: 'A seal of a corporation upon a certificate of stock, corporate bond or other corporate obligation for the payment of money may be facsimile, engraved or printed where such certificate is signed by a transfer agent or transfer clerk and by a registrar, and where such bond or obligation is certified by a trustee,' so that said paragraph, as amended, shall read as follows:

‘XVII. Whenever a corporate seal is used or required
2 on any instrument, an impression made on the paper of
3 such instrument by the seal of the corporation, without any
4 adhesive substance, shall be deemed a valid seal. A seal of
5 a corporation upon a certificate of stock, corporate bond
6 or other corporate obligation for the payment of money may
7 be facsimile, engraved or printed where such certificate is
8 signed by a transfer agent or transfer clerk and by a reg-
9 istrar, and where such bond or obligation is certified by a
10 trustee.’
