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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

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AN ACT Relative to Absent Voting.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred forty-two of chapter thirty-eight of  
2 the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-one is hereby  
3 amended by striking out the words, "a misdemeanor," in  
4 the second line of the last sentence of said section one hun-  
5 dred forty-two, so that said sentence, as amended, shall read  
6 as follows:

'Any failure to comply with the provisions of this section  
2 shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding one thousand  
3 dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding two years.'
