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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE**

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**AN ACT Relating to Deputy Clerk of Courts of Kennebec  
County.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred seventeen of the  
2 revised statutes as amended, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding to paragraph seven of said section, the following  
4 words, 'The deputy clerk of courts shall receive an addi-  
5 tional amount for services as shall be approved by the coun-  
6 ty commissioners not to exceed three hundred dollars an-  
7 nually,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-  
8 lows:

'Kennebec county: for clerks in the office of register of  
2 deeds, twenty-five hundred dollars; for clerks in the office  
3 of register of probate, one thousand and forty dollars; for  
4 clerks in the office of clerk of courts, fifteen hundred dol-  
5 lars; for clerks in the office of county treasurer, three hun-  
6 dred dollars. The deputy clerk of courts shall receive an  
7 additional amount for services, as shall be approved by the  
8 county commissioners not to exceed three hundred dollars  
9 annually.'
