**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE**

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Release the State's Interest in Lots Numbered Three, Four and Six in Township Fifteen, Range Six, West of the East Line of the State, Aroostook County, Maine, to Clara E. Hodgkins of Farmington, Maine.

Resolved: That the forest commissioner be and hereby is
2 authorized to release to Clara E. Hodgkins of Farmington,
3 Maine for two hundred dollars, whatever interest the state
4 of Maine has in lots numbered three, four and six in town-
5 ship fifteen, range six, west of the east line of the state,
6 Aroostook county, Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The husband of Clara E. Hodgkins in his lifetime held a mortgage upon lots numbered three, four and six in township fifteen, range six, west of the east line of the state, Aroostook county, Maine, and upon his death, in attempting to settle the estate, she found that the land had been sold to the forest commissioner for taxes, and this resolve is to clear the title on said real estate.
