STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Expenses and Clerk Hire of the Commissioner of Agriculture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section twenty-one of chapter one hundred seventeen of
2 the revised statutes as amended is hereby further amended
3 by striking out all of said section and inserting in place
4 thereof the following:

'Sect. 21. The department of agriculture. The commis-2 sioner of agriculture shall receive an annual salary of three 3 thousand five hundred dollars. He shall also receive his 4 actual expenses incurred in the performance of his official 5 duties. He may expend for such clerical labor as may be 6 required, an amount to be approved by the governor and 7 council and he may expend such sums for postage, telephone, 8 telegraph and other general office expenses as may be nec-9 essary in the performance of his duties, the same to be paid 10 out of any money appropriated by the legislature for such 11 purpose.'
