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RESOLVE, in Favor of B. E. Lurchin, Compensating Him for  
Storage of Dynamite and Exploders, in His Building.

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Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the  
2 sum of one hundred seventy dollars to B. E. Lurchin of  
3 Pembroke, in Washington county, to compensate him for  
4 the storage of dynamite and exploders in his building.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Lurchin's building was occupied by the state highway commission, for the storage of dynamite and exploders for thirty-four months in the years nineteen hundred twenty, twenty-one, twenty-two and twenty-three.
