STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE

AN ACT Relative to Director of Sea and Shore Fisheries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section seven of chapter two hundred ninety-three of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen, as amended by
3 chapter two hundred seven of the public laws of nineteen
4 hundred twenty-three, is hereby amended by striking out
5 the whole of said section as amended and by substituting in
6 place thereof the following section to be numbered three:

'Sect. 3. Director of sea and shore fisheries; powers and 2 duties. The commission shall appoint a director of sea and 3 shore fisheries who may be removed by them at their pleas-4 ure. He may employ, subject to the approval of the com-

5 mission, one or more clerks and may also incur a reasonable 6 expense for traveling expenses, office rent, postage, print-7 ing, stationery, telephone, and express. He shall have and 8 exercise personal supervision of the work of the department 9 and of the enforcement of the laws relating to sea and shore 10 fisheries by the wardens and shall himself possess all the 11 powers of a warden, and shall possess all the powers and 12 perform all the duties hereinafter specified in this chapter. 13 He shall make a detailed biennial report in the month of 14 December, showing the amount of capital invested in, num-15 ber of persons employed in, value of products of, and any 16 other information that he may be able to obtain relating to 17 the sea and shore fisheries. He shall keep a record of all 18 prosecutions for violations of the laws relating to the sea 19 and shore fisheries, the names of persons or firms prose-20 cuted, the fines imposed and collected in each case and the 21 final disposition of the same, and submit the same in his 22 report, which shall be made to the commission and by them 23 transmitted to the governor and council, with such addi-24 tional statement as they may see fit to make.'
