AN ACT Relative to Lien on Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-six of chapter ninety-six of the revised statutes as amended by chapter one hundred seventy-one of the public laws of nineteen hundred twenty-five is hereby amended by inserting after the word "labor" in the fifth line of said section as amended the words 'and for materials used in performing said labor,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 56. *Lien on Vehicles.* Whoever performs labor by himself or his employees in manufacturing, or repairing the ironwork or woodwork of wagons, carts, sleighs and other

4 vehicles, or provides storage therefor, by direction or con-
5 sent of the owner thereof, shall have a lien on such vehicle
6 for his reasonable charges for said labor and for materials
7 used in performing said labor, and for said storage, which
8 takes precedence of all other claims and incumbrances on
9 said vehicles, not made to secure a similar lien, and may be
10 enforced by attachment at any time within ninety days after
11 the labor is performed and not afterwards, provided, that
12 a claim for such lien is duly filed as required in the follow-
13 ing section; said lien, however, shall be dissolved if said
14 property has actually changed ownership prior to such
15 filing.'
