STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Designate the State Highway leading from Brunswick through Jackman to the Canadian line as The Arnold Trail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The State Highway leading from Brunswick, through Gardiner, Waterville, Norridgewock, Madison, Bingham, and Jackman to the Canadian boundary, known as United States Route 201, is hereby designated as THE ARNOLD TRAIL.
