STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Special Fish and Game Privileges for Permanent Employees and Soldiers of the National Soldiers' Home.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

All employees and soldiers regularly employed at the National Soldiers' Home shall be, and hereby are, classified as residents of this state for the sole purpose of obtaining fishing and hunting licenses, and shall pay the same fees and be held to the same laws, rules and regulations as residents of this state.
