AN ACT to Regulate Fishing in Swift River Tributaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sec. 21, relating to fishing in Bradeen stream, west branch and Walker brook. Section twenty-one of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in the one hundred and tenth line of the thirty-fourth paragraph thereof, after the words "Walker brook" the words 'situated in the counties of Franklin and Oxford,' so that the reference to Swift river tributaries, in lines one hundred nine to one hundred thirteen inclusive of the thirty-fourth paragraph of said section twenty-one shall read as follows: 'Bradeen Stream West Branch (1929, c. 354), and Walker brook, situated in the counties of Franklin and Oxford, and the respective tributaries to each in the towns of Byron, Roxbury, and Mexico, and which flow into Swift river in Oxford county, before July thirteen, nineteen hundred and thirty-four;'
