IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT to Close Duck Pond, known as Meeting House Pond,
and Sprague's Pond, in Phippsburg, to Ice Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, sec. 21, relating to ice fishing in Duck Pond, known as Meeting House Pond, and Sprague's Pond, in Phippsburg. Section twenty-one of chapter thirty-eight of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end of the twentieth paragraph of said section the following: 'Duck Pond, known as Meeting House Pond, and Sprague's Pond, in Phippsburg, in Sagadahoc county.'
