IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Employment of Unlicensed Chauffeurs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Chapter 29 of revised statutes amended. Chapter twenty-nine of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after section thirty-six of said chapter a new section, to be numbered thirty-six A, to read as follows :

'Sect. 36A. Unlawful to employ unlicensed chauffeurs; penalty. No person shall employ for hire a chauffeur of a motor vehicle, any person not licensed as provided in this chapter. No person shall authorize or knowingly permit a motor vehicle owned by him or under his control, to be driven by any person who has no legal right to do so or in violation of this section. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than fifteen dollars.'
